SUMMARY STATEMENT:

The Mat-Su Youth Court requests that \$13,169 be transferred from Fund Balance to Personnel Services to increase the Probation Officer half-time position to a three-quarters position.

The goal set for the increase in the PO position is to increase the quality and scope of case management in the Mat-Su Youth Court by lowering the average sentence completion time from 67 days to 45 days. This goal will be accomplished with two objectives:

The first objective will be to increase contact with the youthful defendants by 100% to insure accountability and timely sentence completion. The increased contact with defendants is accomplished through phone calls and/or office visits. The measurable

outcome for this objective is to increase contact with defendants from a bi-weekly contact to a weekly contact.

The second objective will be to increase contacts with Community Work Service Site Administrator where the defendants are doing their community work service hours by 100%. Currently little or no contact is made with the agency where the defendants do their hours. Having contact with the site will insure that the defendant is timely in contacting the agency, is responsible for showing up, and completing the assigned work. The measurable outcome for this objective is to increase contact with the community work service site from none to at least once during the defendant's sentence completion time.
