All aircraft operating on an airport shall <u>meet</u> [BEAR A CURRENT] air worthiness certificate <u>requirements in accordance with</u> [ISSUED BY THE] Federal Aviation Administration <u>regulations</u>[EXCEPT FEDERAL OR STATE-OWNED AIRCRAFT EXEMPT FROM AIRWORTHINESS CERTIFICATE REQUIREMENTS].
- \* Section 3. Effective date. This ordinance shall take effect upon adoption of the Wasilla City Council.

## **SUMMARY STATEMENT:**

WMC 13.20.120 Admissible Aircraft reads,"All aircraft operating on an airport shall bear a current air worthiness certificate issued by the Federal Aviation administration except federal or state-owned aircraft exempt from air worthiness certificate requirements". This statement only reflects some of the exemptions allowed by FAA for aircraft to be current on their air worthiness certificate requirements. Public Works Department proposes the code to have the following meaning,"All aircraft operating on an airport shall meet air worthiness certificate requirements in accordance with Federal Aviation Administration regulations. This covers all existing and future allowances by FAA.
