AN ORDINANCE OF THE WASILLA CITY COUNCIL AMENDING WMC 10.20.050.A CONCERNING UNAUTHORIZED USE OF PARKING RESERVED FOR PERSONS WITH DISABILITIES.

* Section 1. Classification. This ordinance is of a general and permanent

nature and shall become part of the city code.

* Section 2. Amendment of section. WMC 10.20.050.A, Unauthorized use of

parking reserved for persons with disabilities, is amended to read as follows:

10.20.050 Unauthorized use of parking reserved for persons with disabilities.

A. A person may not park, stop or leave standing an attended or unattended

motor vehicle in a parking place reserved for a person with a disability unless:

1. The motor vehicle displays a special permit issued to the person

operating the vehicle [HAS A SPECIAL PERMIT ISSUED] by the department of

administration under AS 28.10.495, and the person who was issued [HAS] the special

permit actually exits or enters the vehicle:

2. The motor vehicle displays a special permit issued by the department of

administration under AS 28.10.495, the person operating the vehicle has parked the

vehicle for the purpose of transporting the [A] person who [HAS] was issued the [A]

special permit, [ISSUED BY THE DEPARTMENT OF ADMINISTRATION UNDER AS

28.10.495] and the person who [HAS] was issued the special permit actually exits or

enters the vehicle:

- 3. The motor vehicle displays a special license plate issued [TO A PERSON WITH A DISABILITY] under AS 28.10.181(d) to a person with a disability, the person operating the vehicle has parked the vehicle for the purpose of transporting the person who was issued the special license plate [A PERSON WHO HAS A DISABILITY], and the person who [HAS] was issued the special license plate [THE DISABILITY] actually exits or enters the vehicle; or
- 4. The motor vehicle displays a special license plate or permit issued [TO PERSONS WITH DISABILITIES] by another state, province, territory or country to a person with a disability, the person operating the vehicle has parked the vehicle for the purpose of transporting the [A] person who was issued the special license plate or permit [HAS A DISABILITY], and the person who [HAS] was issued the special license plate or permit [THE DISABILITY] actually exits or enters the vehicle.
- * Section 3. Effective date. This ordinance shall take effect upon adoption of the Wasilla City Council.
