SUMMARY STATEMENT: The ordinance is used to close out the funding of several projects that have been completed. The amounts left over from the projects will flow through to each project's Fund balance. \$53,737 will flow through to the Capital Fund's fund balance. \$4,400 will flow through to the Utility Fund's fund balance. \$29,711 will through to the Airport Fund's fund balance.

This close out ordinance will also close out the Wasilla Alternative Corridor Study project. Originally, it was projected that this project funding would be awarded to the City of Wasilla. The State in the end actually appropriated the funds to the Department of Transportation. This closeout ordinance will reduce the revenue and expenditures for this project to zero.

The close out ordinance also closes out the Honor Garden Fund's fund balance to the Capital Reserve Fund's fund balance. The Honor Garden project has been completed and there is approximately \$18,300 of general fund monies that were transferred over to the project. This close out ordinance will transfer these unused monies to the Capital Reserve Fund to be used for future capital projects.
