



**SUMMARY STATEMENT:** The council funded \$12,000 in the CIP budget to upgrade the sound system in council chambers to allow for better sound quality for members of the audience. As you are all aware, we have received numerous complaints from the public over the years about the poor sound quality in chambers especially during crowded meetings.

The purchasing officer solicited for proposals. The proposals were scored and Simplex Grinnell scored the highest. The cost of the project is \$18,510; therefore, we are requesting an additional \$6,510 to fund the project.
