AN ORDINANCE OF THE WASILLA CITY COUNCIL AMENDING THE FY-07 POLICE DEPARTMENT BUDGET BY ACCEPTING AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS FROM THE STATE OF ALASKA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION AND PUBLIC SAFETY OFFICE AND ALASKA HIGHWAY SAFETY OFFICE IN THE AMOUNT OF \$3,580 FOR DRUG EVALUATION AND CLASSIFICATION/DRUG RECOGNITION TRAINING PROGRAM IN PHOENIX, ARIZONA.

Section 1. Classification. This is a non-code ordinance.

Section 2. Purpose. To amend the FY-07 Police Department budget by accepting and appropriating funds from the State of Alaska Department of Transportation and Public Facilities and Alaska Highway Safety Office to the Police Department's budget to cover travel and expenses for Drug Evaluation and Classification/Drug Recognition Expert Training Program in Phoenix, Arizona. The City of Wasilla is contributing matching funds in the amount of \$6,340.02 for personnel services.

DOT&PF/Highway Safety Funds 001-4200-334.20-01 \$3,580.00


Section 5. Effective date. This ordinance shall take effect upon adoption of the Wasilla City Council.

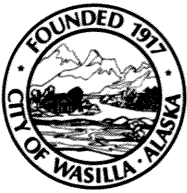
