**SUMMARY STATEMENT:** Recently three lots adjacent to Nunley Park were placed on the market for sale. There was discussion at several Parks and Recreation Commission meetings regarding the possible purchase of these three lots by the City of Wasilla. Several Commissioners expressed a desire to purchase this property to add to the current size of Nunley Park. Nunley Park is a very heavily used neighborhood park and on any given day more than 40 children and adults will participate in various activities. By acquiring these three lots, additional space will be made available to increase picnic areas, activity space or more parking.

The Commissioners agreed that if the opportunity arose that the city should consider the purchase of these three lots to add to the Nunley Park Townsite. Additionally, in Parks and Recreation Commission Resolution Serial Number 06-05, the Commission recommended to the City of Wasilla Council to consider the purchase of any land available for expansion of present parks or the development of future parks and related facilities. This Resolution was adopted at a regularly scheduled meeting on November 8, 2006.
