- * Section 1. Classification. This ordinance is of a general and permanent nature and shall become part of the city code.
- * Section 2. Amendment of section. Subsection A of WMC 5.16.125, Application of sales tax payments, is amended to read as follows:
- 5.16.125 Application of sales tax payments.
- A. <u>Except as this section provides otherwise</u>, p[P]ayments on sales tax accounts shall be applied to the amount due for each calendar month, in chronological order, and within the amount due for each calendar month first to accrued penalty, second to accrued interest and then to the sales tax payments owed by the seller [IN THE ORDER OF THEIR DUE DATES, EXCEPT AS THIS SECTION PROVIDES OTHERWISE].
- * Section 3. Effective date. This ordinance shall take effect upon adoption by the Wasilla City Council.
