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### RESOLUTION NO. WR90-17

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF WASILLA, ALASKA SUPPORTING PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO WASILLA DEVELOPMENT CODE REGARDING JUNKYARDS.

WHEREAS, the Wasilla Planning and Utilities Commission held a public hearing on September 26, 1989 and heard testimony on the proposed regulation of junkyards within the City of Wasilla; and

WHEREAS, the Commission has recommended that future junkyards be permitted only in industrial (IND) zones; and

WHEREAS, the Commission has revised and approved WPUC Resolution 89-05 at their regular meeting of April 24, 1990 calling for necessary revisions of the Wasilla Development Code.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Wasilla City Council that WPUC Resolution 89-05 is hereby approved and forwarded to the Matanuska-Susitna Borough for formal code revision; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Council recommends that the existing definition of junkyard (17.43.202 "Junkyard") be reviewed and revised to more clearly distinguish a junkyard or materials salvage business from similar minimal incidental activities at residences and other business.
