### RESOLUTION NO. WR95-02

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF WASILLA, ALASKA REQUESTING THAT THE ALASKA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION AND PUBLIC FACILITIES POST CRUSEY STREET SPEED LIMIT AT 30 M.P.H.

WHEREAS, Alaska Department of Transportation and Public Facilities maintains Crusey Street within the Wasilla city limits; and

WHEREAS, speed limit signs do not presently exist on Crusey Street; and

WHEREAS, ADOT/PF reports that complaints have been received from drivers who have been cited for exceeding the State's "default speed limit" of 25 mph (presumably exceeding that speed significantly); and

WHEREAS, the original posted speed on Crusey Street was 40 mph and a new traffic order has been issued by ADOT/PF to re-post the 40 mph limit and Wasilla city police, staff, members of the Council and other interested persons have suggested that 40 mph is too high considering the length of the street, existing school zone, traffic volumes, high traffic driveways, vertical sight distance and extended traffic queues at the Parks Highway intersection.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Wasilla City Council respectfully requests that Alaska Department of Transportation and Public Facilities reconsider its current traffic order and reduce the Crusey Street speed limit to 30 mph.

I certify that a resolution in substantially the above form was passed by a majority of those voting at a duly called and conducted meeting of the governing body of the City of Wasilla, Alaska this 9<sup>th</sup> day of January, 1995.
