RESOLUTION NO. WR95-05

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF WASILLA, ALASKA PROMOTING SAFE SCHOOLS AND SAFE COMMUNITIES.

WHEREAS, there are increasing instances of violence and vandalism among our youth in schools and in the community; and

WHEREAS, schools exist in all communities and are a focus of community activity as related to youth; and

WHEREAS, we all have a responsibility as community members to guide our youth in appropriate behavior; and

WHEREAS, a state-wide campaign, would be appropriate during Valentine Week (February 12 to February 18) which is traditionally viewed as a time of caring,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Wasilla City Council encourages all Alaska communities and School Boards to work together with our partners in education, community service and law enforcement to launch a state-wide effort to increase awareness and bring change to increase safety for our students and our communities. This effort would involve the entire community (families, businesses, churches, community groups and youth organizations).
