RESOLUTION NO. WR95-09

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF WASILLA, ALASKA ENDORSING THE PRIVATE NOT-FOR-PROFIT DEVELOPMENT OF SPORT FIELDS IN WASILLA.

WHEREAS, there have been numerous requests for a variety of sport fields in Wasilla; and

WHEREAS, the Wasilla City Council wishes to endorse the efforts made by sports organizations to provide a more productive form of entertainment for people of all ages; and

WHEREAS, the Wasilla City Council recognizes the need to assist sports organizations in accomplishing this goal; and

WHEREAS, property is available that could be developed into a variety of sport fields;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Wasilla City Council wishes to work with not-for-profit sports organizations through their development of identified City property into sport fields; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Wasilla City Council requests the Parks & Recreation Commission to help identify:


1. sporting activities that have a need for fields;
2. sporting activities that are able to utilize the same fields;
3. specifications for fields to support these sporting activities; and
4. public areas to be developed into sport fields; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Wasilla City Council requests the Mayor to develop:

1. An agreement to be utilized between sports organizations and the City of Wasilla for not-for-profit agency development of sport fields dealing with implications of "public construction" and "mental health trust lands"; and
2. A plan for cooperative use of fields.


