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## RESOLUTION NO. WR95-25

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF WASILLA, ALASKA DIRECTING THAT A SURVEY BE TAKEN OF THE BENEFITED PROPERTY OWNERS FOR THE PURPOSE OF INITIATING WATER LINE CONSTRUCTION WITHIN THE CITY OF WASILLA.

## **WEST PARKS HIGHWAY WATER DISTRICT**

WHEREAS, property owners have requested that water lines be extended; and

WHEREAS, costs of the requested water line extension have been obtained; and

WHEREAS, the City Council must receive approval of the property owners who will bear the majority of the assessable project costs before proceeding with the project;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED,

- (1) That the City Council hereby directs that a survey be taken among owners of benefited property within the area on the attached map and referred to as West Parks Highway Water District described below, located in Sections 8 and 9, Township 17 North, Range 1 West, Seward Meridian.
  - Lots 1A, and 11C through 19, Block 3, and Tract A, Wasilla Heights Addition #1; Lots 37A, 39 through 41, and 44 through 48A, Block 2, Wasilla Airport Heights; and Lot 1, Morehouse Subdivision.
- (2) Pending availability of funding, the City of Wasilla will pay 50% of the project costs. The remaining 50% of project costs are to be divided equally by square foot by area among all benefited lot owners in the district.
- (3) Interest rate to be the rate charged by our lender plus 1% for reserves.
- (4) The assessments will be payable over a 10-year schedule.
- (5) That a public hearing will be held in the City Council Chambers, 290 E. Herning Avenue, 7:00 p.m., August 28, 1995 on the necessity of the water extension project and to hear any protests. Protests returned after the close of the public hearing will not be considered.

I certify that a resolution in substantially the above from was passed by a majority of those voting at a duly called and conducted meeting of the governing body of the City of Wasilla this 24th day of July, 1995.
