A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF WASILLA CITY COUNCIL AUTHORIZING PARTICIPATION IN THE MINI-GRANT PROGRAM.

WHEREAS, the Mat-Su Small Business Development Center (MSSBDC) wishes to provide a shared-use production kitchen for use in the community; and

WHEREAS, MSSBDC may be a joint applicant with the City for a grant in the amount of \$15,000 for a feasibility study from the Alaska Department of Community and Regional Affairs (Department), under the Mini-Grant program.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Mayor of the City of Wasilla is hereby authorized to negotiate and execute any and all documents required for accepting grant funds from the Department and managing funds on behalf of MSSBDC.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Mayor is also authorized to execute subsequent amendments to said grant agreement to provide for adjustments to the project within the scope of services or tasks, based upon the needs of the project.

## JOINT APPLICATION AGREEMENT

WHEREAS, Mat-Su Small Business Development Center has identified need in the community to expand economic opportunities; and

Noting contained in this agreement shall deprive any applicant of any power of zoning, development control or other lawful authority which it presently possesses.
