RESOLUTION NO. WR96-41

A RESOLUTION OF THE WASILLA CITY COUNCIL ACCEPTING MAINTENANCE AND OPERATION OF PROPOSED PEDESTRIAN/BIKE TRAILS ON KNIK-GOOSE BAY AND BOGARD ROADS.

WHEREAS, pedestrian/bike trails are highly valued by Wasilla citizens because they provide safe, non-motorized routes within the City; and

WHEREAS, the construction of pedestrian/bike trails within the City is encouraged by the comprehensive plan and is a high Council and Administration priority; and

WHEREAS, the State of Alaska Department of Transportation and Public Facilities has developed a project to construct pedestrian/bike trails on Knik-Goose Bay Road and Bogard Road within the corporate limits of Wasilla; and

WHEREAS, the project ranking for state and federal funding will be significantly higher if the City will accept ongoing operation and maintenance; and

WHEREAS, the City of Wasilla has the statutory authority to operate and maintain pedestrian/bike trails.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and City Council of Wasilla that the City agrees to accept ongoing operation and maintenance responsibilities for the pedestrian/bicycle trails to be constructed by the State of Alaska Department of Transportation and Public Facilities on Knik-Goose Bay Road and Bogard Road within the city limits.
