

**COOPERATIVE AGREEMENT**  
**CITY/BOROUGH RESOLUTION NUMBER WR96-53**

An agreement by and between the City of Wasilla  
and Mat-Su Services for Children and Adults, Inc.

**WITNESSETH:**

**WHEREAS,** the City of Wasilla and Mat-Su Services, Inc (has/have) identified need in the community ~~(types)~~ to expand economic opportunities; and

**WHEREAS,** (municipal entity) the City of Wasilla contemplates submitting on behalf of (non-municipal entity) Mat-Su Services for Children and Adults an application for CDBG Grant Funds from the Department of Community and Regional Affairs for the purpose of meeting such needs; and

**WHEREAS,** the City of Wasilla and Mat-Su Services desire, and are required to, enter into a written cooperative agreement with each other to participate in such CDBG program; and

**WHEREAS,** the City of Wasilla and Mat-Su Services understand that the City of Wasilla will act as the applicant and will have the ultimate responsibility to assume all obligations under terms of the grant including assuring compliance with all applicable laws and program regulations and performance of all work in accordance with the contract. Further, the Mayor or Mayor's designee will be the contact person for this project; and

**WHEREAS,** it is understood that the City of Wasilla and DCRA have access to all participants' grant records and authority to monitor all activities.

**NOW, THEREFORE,** it is mutually agreed between the City of Wasilla and Mat-Su Services for Children and Adults as follows:

1. The City of Wasilla and Mat-Su Services must assure that the severely disabled persons in Wasilla will receive some specific benefit (i.e., usefulness, advantage, return) for the residents of the rural community for a specified period of time.
2. The City of Wasilla and Mat-Su Services agree to cooperate in the submission of an application for such CDBG grant funds, and agree to cooperate in implementation of the submitted CDBG program, as approved by the Department of Community and Regional Affairs.

Nothing contained in this agreement shall deprive any municipality of any power or zoning, development control, or other lawful authority which it presently possesses.
