RESOLUTION NO. WR97-21

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF WASILLA, ALASKA DIRECTING THAT A SURVEY BE TAKEN OF THE BENEFITED PROPERTY OWNERS FOR THE PURPOSE OF INITIATING ROAD PAVING WITHIN THE CITY OF WASILLA.

MELANIE PAVING DISTRICT

WHEREAS, property owners have requested that road paving improvements be made; and

WHEREAS, costs of the requested improvements and paving Melanie Avenue, Success Avenue, Recluse Circle, and a portion of Mystery Avenue have been obtained; and

WHEREAS, the City Council may proceed with improvements unless the property owners who will bear fifty percent (50%) or more of the estimated assessable cost of the project protest in writing;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

(1) That the City Council hereby directs that a survey be taken among owners of benefited property within the area colored on the attached map referred to as the Melanie Paving L.I.D. described below, located in Section 5, Township 17 North, Range 1 West, Seward Meridian.

Lots 1 - 5, Block 1, Upper Wasilla Heights
Lots 1 - 5, Block 2, Upper Wasilla Heights
Lot 17, Block 1, Wasilla Acres
Lots 18 - 34, Block 5, Wasilla Acres
Lots 1 - 20, Block 6, Wasilla Acres
Lots 1 - 9, Block 1, Northern Capital Estates
Lots 1 - 6 & 16 - 36, Block 2, Northern Capital Estates
Lots 1 - 18, Block 3, Northern Capital Estates
Lots 1 - 12, Block 4, Northern Capital Estates


(2) The City of Wasilla will pay 66-2/3% of the project costs. The remaining costs are estimated assessments to be levied equally among the owners of benefited lots in the district.

(3) The assessments will be payable over a 10-year schedule with interest at the rate to be established by the Council.

(4) That a public hearing will be held in the City Council Chambers, 290 East Herring Avenue, 7:00 p.m., August 11, 1997 on the necessity of the paving project and to hear any protests. Protests returned after the close of the public hearing will not be considered.

I certify that a resolution in substantially the above form was passed by a majority of those voting at a duly called and conducted meeting of the governing body of the City of Wasilla this 23rd day of June, 1997.
