RESOLUTION SERIAL NO. WR97-48

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF WASILLA, ALASKA, REQUESTING THE STATE OF ALASKA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION TO PROHIBIT THE USE OF ENGINE BRAKES IN THE CITY OF WASILLA.

WHEREAS, residents of the City of Wasilla are affected by the sound engine brakes produce.

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the city council to request the State of Alaska Department of Transportation to limit noise within the Wasilla City limits to make a peaceful environment for their residents.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Wasilla City Council urges the State of Alaska Department of Transportation to place signs on the Parks Highway, Wasilla-Fishhook Road, Bogard Road, Lucille Street, Palmer-Wasilla Highway, and Knik-Goose Bay Road asking large commercial diesel trucks to avoid the use of engine brakes within the Wasilla City limits.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Wasilla City Council agrees to pay for the costs of the signs to be provided by the State of Alaska Department of Transportation.
