A RESOLUTION OF WASILLA CITY COUNCIL REPEALING RESOLUTION SERIAL NO. WR96-61 RELATING TO THE POLICY ON ANNEXATION OF PROPERTY TO THE CITY OF WASILLA.

WHEREAS, Resolution Serial No. WR 96-61 established a policy on annexation; and

WHEREAS, Resolution Serial No. WR 96-61 only mentions one method of annexation; and

WHEREAS, the city council and the city clerk are inappropriately assigned the administrative duties of the annexation process.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Wasilla City Council hereby repeal Resolution Serial No. WR 96-61 in its entirety.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the following policy is established to assist the mayor and administration in providing the most efficient manner for annexation of property into the city of Wasilla:

- 1. Territory adjacent to the city of Wasilla will be considered for annexation under the Alaska Administrative Code and the Alaska State Statues.
- 2. The mayor shall assign administrative duties to the appropriate city department.
- 3. All proposed annexation with supporting documentation shall be brought to the council for approval before submission to the local boundary commission.
