RESOLUTION NO. 98-10

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF WASILLA, ALASKA, REQUESTING SAFE COMMUNITIES FUNDING FROM THE DEPARTMENT OF COMMUNITY AND REGIONAL AFFAIRS.

WHEREAS, AS 29.60.350(b) requires the governing body of a municipality to adopt a resolution requesting safe communities funding and to submit the resolution to the Department of community and Regional Affairs; and


WHEREAS, the City of Wasilla is desirous of receiving safe communities funding; and

WHEREAS, AS 26.60.350(c) requires that money received by a municipality under the safe communities program be used only for the following services in the following ranking of priority:

- 1) police protection and related public safety services;
- 2) fire protection and emergency medical services;
- 3) water and sewer services not offset by user fees;
- 4) solid waste management; and
- 5) other services determined by the governing body to have the highest priority.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Wasilla City Council hereby requests payment from the Safe Communities Program by the Department of Community and Regional Affairs and agrees to spend such payment as required by law.
