## CITY OF WASILLA RESOLUTION SERIAL NO. 99-05

A RESOLUTION OF THE WASILLA CITY COUNCIL REQUESTING SAFE COMMUNITIES FUNDING FROM THE STATE OF ALASKA, DEPARTMENT OF COMMUNITY AND REGIONAL AFFAIRS.

WHEREAS, AS 29.60.350(B) requires the governing body of a municipality to adopt a resolution requesting safe communities funding and to submit the resolution to the Department of Community and Regional Affairs; and

WHEREAS, AS 26.60.350© requires that money received by a municipality under the safe communities program be used only for the following services in the following ranking of priority:

- 1) police protection and related public safety services;
- 2) fire protection and emergency medical services;
- 3) water and sewer services not offset by user fees;
- 4) solid waste management; and
- 5) other services determined by the governing body to have the highest priority.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Wasilla City Council hereby requests payment from the Safe Communities Program by the Department of Community and Regional Affairs and agrees to spend such payment as required by law.

ADOPTED by the Wasilla City Council on March 8, 1999.
