A RESOLUTION OF THE WASILLA CITY COUNCIL TO RENAME SOUTH RAINER DRIVE AND A PORTION OF EAST GLENWOOD AVENUE TO PALMER-WASILLA HIGHWAY.

WHEREAS, the Palmer-Wasilla Highway extension project overlaps Rainer Drive and a portion of Glenwood Avenue; and,

WHEREAS, the Wasilla Planning Commission held a public hearing on April 13, 1999 to hear public testimony regarding the proposed road renaming; and

WHEREAS, the proposed street name complies with WMC 17.01.010; and

WHEREAS, in compliance with WMC 17.01.013 (D), the Matanuska-Susitna Borough has provided a letter of no conflict to the proposed road name; and

WHEREAS, the Wasilla Planning Commission Resolution No. 99-06(A) recommends to the Wasilla City Council that the overlapped portion of East Glenwood Avenue be renamed East Palmer-Wasilla Highway.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Wasilla City Council rename the overlapped portion of East Glenwood Avenue to East Palmer-Wasilla Highway;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the Wasilla City Council rename South Rainer Drive to Palmer-Wasilla Highway;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the rename coincide with the completion of the Palmer-Wasilla Highway Extension.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Public Works Department will advertise in a local newspaper and send formal notice to the Matanuska-Susitna Borough and the United States Postal Service of this street name change a minimum of 30 days prior to the opening of the Palmer-Wasilla Highway Extension for through traffic;
