WHEREAS, the Wasilla City Council has passed a vendor ordinance for city properties and right-of-ways requesting the Parks and Recreation Commission to make recommendations on sites, times and number of permits; and

WHEREAS, the Parks and Recreation Commission has assessed each park in the city and has adopted Parks and Recreation Commission Resolution No. 99-04.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Wasilla City Council approves the following vendor sites for public use areas as:

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the council approves that no more than four roving vendor permits and no more than four permanent vendor permits will be issued each year; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the council approves that roving vendors may visit the public use areas only once every four hours, for a period of 30 minutes at each visit to create the least impact on the public use areas; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the park maintenance supervisor shall determine the exact location for vendor use areas within each public use area: and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the council approves that the public use areas are available for vendors between the hours of 8 a.m. and 11 p.m. daily unless otherwise specified by administration.
