## CITY OF WASILLA RESOLUTION SERIAL NO. 99-32

A RESOLUTION TO DESIGNATE ALASKA DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL CONSERVATION MATCHING MUNICIPAL GRANT FUNDS TO THE DRINKING WATER MASTER PLAN AND WATER SOURCE EXPLORATION AS THE NUMBER ONE LOCAL STATE FUNDING PRIORITY FOR FISCAL YEAR 2001.

WHEREAS, the City of Wasilla through the Municipal Grants Program administered by the Alaska Department of Environmental Conservation will request a grant of \$450,000 for the purpose of conducting a drinking water source and storage master plan and to conduct exploratory well drilling; and

WHEREAS, the Alaska Department of Environmental Conservation has requested that the City of Wasilla identify the city's number one local state funding priority for the fiscal year 2001; and

WHEREAS, the City of Wasilla is one of the fastest growing communities in the United States: and

WHEREAS, to protect and enhance the quantity and quality of the City's drinking water source to ensure public health; and

WHEREAS, to provide adequate fire protection water quantities for properties within the City limits; and

WHEREAS, a master plan and exploratory wells are needed before permanent water utility improvements can be planned and constructed.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Wasilla City Council designates the Drinking Water Master Plan and Water Source Exploration as the number one local state funding priority for fiscal year 2001.

ADOPTED by the Wasilla City Council on September 13, 1999.
