WHEREAS, the Greater Wasilla Chamber of Commerce sponsored and passed Resolution 99-06, a joint resolution of the Big Lake, Greater Palmer, Houston, Greater Wasilla, and Willow Chambers of Commerce in support of the Matanuska-Susitna Borough development of designated multi-use trails throughout the core area of Palmer and Wasilla, and

WHEREAS, the Wasilla Parks and Recreation Commission has passed Resolution Serial No. 99-08 which advocates the use of Department of Natural Resources Snowmobile Grant Program for trail grooming.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, the Wasilla City Council supports a snowmobile grant for trail grooming and supports a 100 per cent match either through force account labor or matching funds, limited match not to exceed \$6000.
