**A RESOLUTION OF THE WASILLA CITY COUNCIL, WASILLA, ALASKA,
SELECTING THE COMMUNITY'S TOP PRIORITY PROJECT FOR THE COMMUNITY
DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT PROGRAM APPLICATION.**

WHEREAS, the city of Wasilla desires to apply for a Community Development Block Grant through the State of Alaska, Department of Community and Economic Development; and

WHEREAS, the city of Wasilla has advertised in the local newspaper for project nominations; and

WHEREAS, the city of Wasilla has advertised in the local newspaper for public participation and comments in selecting the community's top priority project for the Community Development Block Grant application; and

WHEREAS, the Wasilla Planning Commission advertised in the local newspaper of a public hearing to allow public participation in selecting the community's top priority project for the Community Development Block Grant application; and

WHEREAS, the public participated in the November 14, 2000 public hearing and provided comments in support of various projects for the Community Development Block Grant; and

WHEREAS, the public participated in the November 14, 2000 public hearing and provided comments from the WPC in support of the sewer and water extension for the Low-Moderate Income Multi-family Development proposed by Valley Residential


Services as the community's top priority for the Community Development Block Grant;
and

WHEREAS, the sewer and water extension for the Low-Moderate Income Multi-family Development proposed by Valley Residential Services meets the eligibility criteria for the Community Development Block Grant program; and

WHEREAS, this project develops infrastructure for community/economic development attracts other public and private funds and resources to the community and has the potential for long-term benefit.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Wasilla City Council of the City of Wasilla, hereby recommends an extension of the sewer and water for the Low-Moderate Income Multi-family Development proposed by Valley Residential Services as the community's priority selection for the Community Development Block Grant.
