A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF WASILLA MOURNING THE LOSS OF FELLOW CITIZENS WHO HAVE PERISHED OR BEEN INJURED BY THE TERRORIST ATTACK ON THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA WHICH OCCURRED ON SEPTEMBER 11, 2001.

Whereas, the evildoers who devised these despicable attacks on the innocent citizens of New York City, the Pentagon and those who boarded planes in the United States of America; and

Now therefore be it resolved that the citizens of Wasilla, Alaska mourn for their fellow citizens who have perished or been injured by this dastardly intrusion; and


