**A RESOLUTION OF THE WASILLA CITY COUNCIL THAT AUTHORIZES THE CITY
TO APPLY FOR A LOAN FROM THE ALASKA DRINKING WATER FUND FOR THE
WATER MAIN IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM**

WHEREAS the City of Wasilla (the City) seeks to obtain the necessary financial assistance to construct water main improvements along the Palmer-Wasilla Highway Extension, West Parks Highway, and Lucille Street; and


WHEREAS, the State of Alaska, Department of Environmental Conservation (the Department) is able to offer funding through the Alaska Drinking Water Fund; and

WHEREAS, the City wishes to apply for a loan from the Alaska Drinking Water fund; and

WHEREAS, if the loan is approved by the Department, an additional resolution will be issued to authorize the acceptance of a loan offer from the Alaska Drinking Water Fund.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Wasilla City Council that the City is authorized to apply to the Department for a loan from the Alaska Drinking Water Fund for the Water Main Improvement Program.
