RESOLUTION SERIAL NO. 02-04**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE WASILLA CITY COUNCIL IN SUPPORT OF A VOLUNTARY "ANNUAL CLEAN-UP CAMPAIGN" DURING 2002 AND 2003, IN COOPERATION WITH THE MATANUSKA – SUSITNA BOROUGH, THE ALASKA ARMY NATIONAL GUARD AND OTHER ORGANIZATIONS TO REMOVE JUNK.**

WHEREAS, unwanted junk vehicles and junk metal are creating a nuisance that is unsightly and harmful to the environment and the quality of our community; and

WHEREAS, the Matanuska – Susitna Borough is proposing a voluntary "Annual Clean-Up Campaign" during 2002 and 2003, in cooperation with the Alaska Army National Guard, Community Councils, Village Councils, and other organizations to remove Junk; and


WHEREAS, the Matanuska- Susitna Borough and the Alaska Army National Guard must have statements from interested community groups requesting this clean up project in 'their community and committing to actively help plan and conduct the project; and

WHEREAS, the City of Wasilla requests assistance from the Matanuska – Susitna Borough to conduct an "Annual Clean – Up" in August, 2002 or May, 2003 in our community, especially removal of junk vehicles and junk metal; and

WHEREAS, the City of Wasilla requests the Alaska Army National Guard remove junk vehicles and metal, from our city during 2002 or 2003.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that this request is approved, and the Wasilla City Council agrees to host an "Annual Clean Up" project by providing local leadership and support for a successful project. We will work with the Borough, the Alaska Army National Guard and organizations conducting these projects. The City of Wasilla will provide volunteers to: help plan and conduct the project, locate "junk drop off site(s)", spread the word in the community, assist with paperwork, donate services or products, direct activities at "drop off" sites, perform other necessary tasks, as required. The City of Wasilla will designate a local project coordinator to be responsible for representation, and performance, of the City in this project.
