A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF WASILLA APPROVING THE USE OF IDITAPARK FOR THE TREATMENT OF STORM WATER.

WHEREAS, the City has completed a Storm Water Master Plan that identifies Iditapark as the primary area for the treatment of storm water for the next 15 years; and

WHEREAS, Iditapark provides a natural recharge area for the treated storm water to support Lake Lucille; and

WHEREAS, the City has received a \$1.2 million dollar grant from the Alaska Department of Environmental Conservation to construct the storm water system; and

WHEREAS, the City will use a series of ponds and meadows to treat storm water and to recharge the ground water aquifer that supports Lake Lucille; and

WHEREAS, the City will construct the storm water ponds and meadows to be consistent with the Iditapark Master Plan and enhance the park with riparian areas.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the ponds and meadows shown on the Draft 1999 Iditapark Master Plan be dedicated for the treatment of storm water and to recharge the ground water aquifer that supports Lake Lucille.
