RESOLUTION SERIAL NO. 03-23**

A RESOLUTION OF THE WASILLA CITY COUNCIL TO DESIGNATE ALASKA DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL CONSERVATION MUNICIPAL GRANT FUNDS TO THE STORM WATER PUMPING AND TREATMENT FACILITY PHASE II AS THE NUMBER ONE LOCAL STATE FUNDING PRIORITY FOR FISCAL YEAR 2005.

WHEREAS, the City of Wasilla through the Municipal Grants Program administered by the Alaska Department of Environmental Conservation will request \$455,500 for the City's Storm Water Pumping and Treatment Facility Phase II; and

WHEREAS, the Alaska Department of Environmental Conservation has requested that the City of Wasilla identify the City's number one local state funding priority for fiscal year 2005; and

WHEREAS, the Storm Water Pumping and Treatment Facility is designed to replace the City's existing failing drywell system and intercept a portion of the storm water entering Lake Lucille; and

WHEREAS, this project is a joint venture with the Alaska Department of Transportation and Public Facilities and the City to reduce future storm water impact to Cottonwood Creek.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Wasilla City Council designates the Storm Water Pumping and Treatment Facility Phase II as the number one local state funding priority for fiscal year 2005.

ADOPTED by the Wasilla City Council on August 11, 2003.
