- * Section 1. Classification. This ordinance is of a general and permanent nature and shall become part of the city code.
- * Section 2. Amendment of subsection. WMC 2.60.010C, Planning Commission, Establishment, duties and compensation, is amended to read as follows:
- C. The compensation of each commission member shall be <u>fifty</u> [TWENTY-FIVE] dollars (\$50[25].00) per meeting <u>attended</u>.
- * Section 3. Amendment of subsection. WMC 2.64.010D, Parks and Recreation Commission, Establishment, purpose, duties and compensation, is amended to read as follows:
- D. The compensation of each commission member shall be <u>fifty</u> [TWENTY-FIVE] dollars (\$50[25].00)] per <u>meeting attended</u> [MONTH, PROVIDED THAT THE MEMBER ATTENDS AT LEAST ONE MEETING OR ONE WORK SESSION THAT MONTH].
- * Section 4. Effective date. This ordinance shall take effect on July 1, 2003. ADOPTED by the Wasilla City Council, Alaska, on April 28, 2003.
