**A RESOLUTION OF THE WASILLA CITY COUNCIL AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO APPLY FOR AND ACCEPT GRANTS IN THE AMOUNT OF \$2.28 MILLION FROM THE FEDERAL TRANSIT ADMINISTRATION FOR THE CITY OF WASILLA INTERMODAL FACILITY AND BUS FACILITY.**

WHEREAS, the Federal Transit Administration has appropriated funding in the amount of \$2.28 million for the Wasilla Intermodal Facility and the Wasilla Bus facility, and

WHEREAS, the Wasilla Intermodal Facility will provide a train depot near the Wasilla Airport, and


WHEREAS, the Wasilla Bus Facility will provide a maintenance facility with dispatch/administration offices for MASCOT, the community's non-profit bus service.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Wasilla City Council authorizes the Mayor to apply for and accept Federal Transit Administration Grant Funding in the Amount of \$2.28 million for the Wasilla Intermodal Facility and Bus Facility.

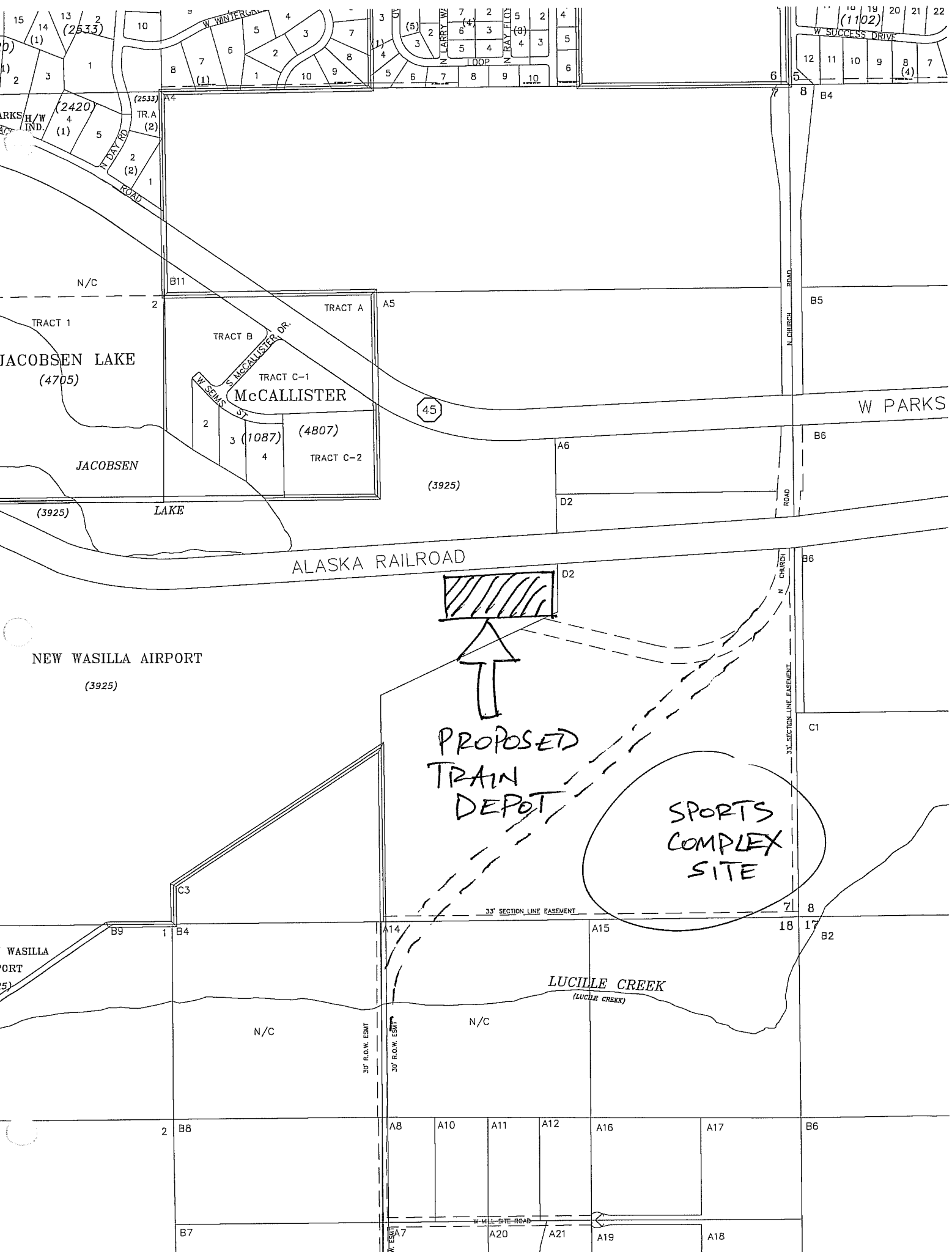

**SUMMARY STATEMENT:**

This Resolution is required before the City can apply for and accept Federal Transit Administration Grant funding. The FTA Grants include the Wasilla Bus Facility and the Wasilla Intermodal Facility, totaling \$2.28 million. The City is contributing its \$594,000 FTA grant, along with MASCOT's \$800,000 FTA Grant that the City will administer for the bus facility. This will be a maintenance and office building for MASCOT. MASCOT will be required to obtain a \$300,000 match for this project.

The intermodal facility consists of a new train depot near the airport and sports complex, using an FTA earmark to the City, in the amount of \$886,000. The City will need to provide a 20 percent match for this project.

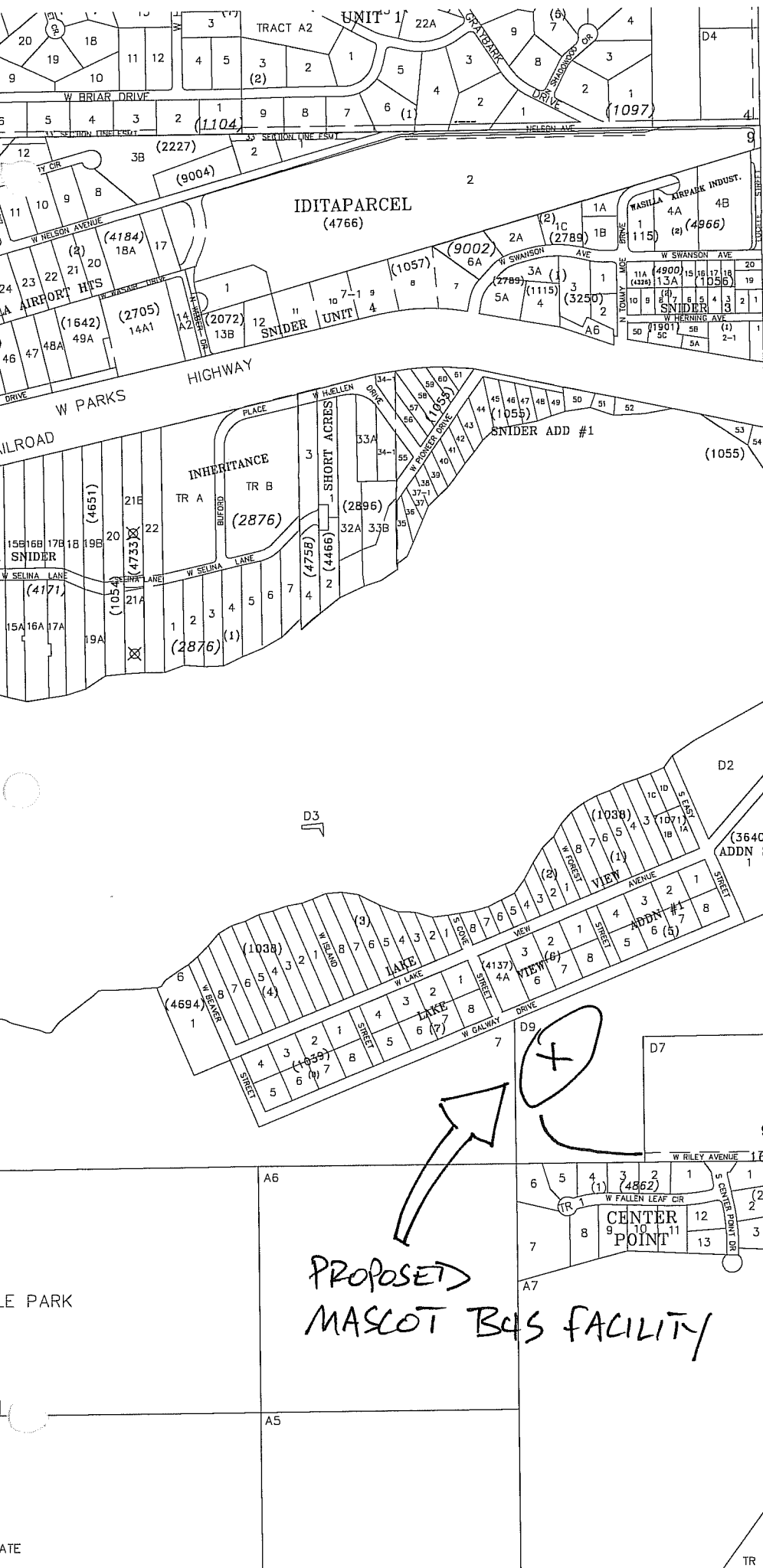

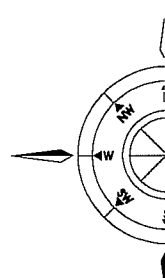
