SUMMARY STATEMENT: These funds will be used to purchase a Records Management System, to pay for a Field Reporting module for patrol officers and to establish the foundation for a mobile data network for public safety in the Mat-Su. The technology solutions will be available to multiple public safety agencies and will allow for better tracking of cases, suspects and premise histories. The Field Reporting module will allow officers to complete reports more quickly, which means the District Attorney, Courts and public will all benefit. Local public safety will develop better multi agency interoperability and the officers on the street will have access to the information they need when responding to emergencies and citizen complaints in a more timely and effective manner. The mobile wireless solution will give officers more capability on patrol as well as taking some work off the dispatchers in the communications center.

Some of these funds will go towards consultant fees as well as multiple software applications.
