MOTORCYCLE OFFICER FUNDING IN THE AMOUNT OF \$45,554 FROM THE
STATE OF ALASKA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION AND CITY MATCH IN
THE AMOUNT OF \$5,066.**

WHEREAS, AS 29.60.350(b) requires a governing body of a municipality to adopt a resolution requesting Motorcycle Officer funding and to submit the resolution to the State of Alaska Department of Transportation; and

WHEREAS, the City of Wasilla wishes to receive the Motorcycle Officer funding;
and

WHEREAS, AS 29.60.350(c) requires that money received by a municipality under the State of Alaska Department of Transportation grant be used only for the

following services: Personnel	\$25,635
Travel	\$3,692
Contractual Services	\$1740
Commodities	\$1,925
Equipment	\$17,628

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Wasilla City Council that we accept grant funding in the amount of \$45,554 from the State of Alaska Department of Transportation and city match in the amount of \$5,066; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that we agree to spend such funding as required by law.





