**SUMMARY STATEMENT:** The recent airport apron project constructed aircraft tiedown spaces with electrical service. Pilots will use the electrical service primarily in the winter to preheat engines prior to takeoff. The design engineer has estimated the average electrical usage will be \$15 per month over a 1-year period.

The current aircraft tie-down rate is \$25 per month. The administration is proposing a \$15 per month increase for tie-down spaces that have electrical service. All of the tie-down spaces with electrical service are on one electrical meter and it is not practical to have individual meters for each space. Therefore a flat rate has been proposed that will be evaluated and adjusted at the end of 1 year.
