A RESOLUTION OF THE WASILLA CITY COUNCIL SUPPORTING THE ENHANCED 911 ADVISORY BOARD PRIORITIES FOR FISCAL YEAR 2006 ALLOCATION OF ENHANCED 911 FUNDS.

WHEREAS, the City of Wasilla, the City of Houston and the City of Palmer, the State of Alaska Department of Public Safety and the Matanuska-Susitna Borough met with Senator Lyda Green and agreed to enter into an agreement which described the process for prioritizing the allocation of E-911 Funds for Fiscal Year 2006; and

WHEREAS, the E-911 Advisory Board has recommended that funds be allocated first to the telephone company, second to the E-911 system infrastructure and third to recurring direct E-911 costs; and

WHEREAS, the Matanuska-Susitna Borough has estimated an E-911 revenue of \$660,140 which is based on an E-911 surcharge of 75 cents per line per month.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Wasilla City Council supports the Matanuska-Susitna Enhanced 911 Advisory Board priorities for the Fiscal Year 2006 allocation of Enhanced 911 funds.
