SUMMARY STATEMENT: An emergency generator was installed at the sewer treatment plant in 2004 using a municipal grant from the Alaska, Department of Environmental Conservation. The emergency generator installation came in under budget with \$27,248 remaining in the grant. The grant was re-appropriated by the legislature last year for additional work at the sewer treatment plant. The planned work includes expanding the sewer treatment plant to meet demands beyond 2015. The grant funds will begin the design of a third lagoon and additional drainfields to increase system capacity from 600,000 gallons per day to 1 million gallons per day. Current use at the treatment plant ranges between 300,000 – 400,000 gallons per day. The administration is lobbying for additional design funding and construction funding for this project.

RECOMMENDED ACTION: Adopt Resolution Serial No. 06-11 that authorizes the Mayor to execute a grant agreement with the Alaska, Department of Environmental Conservation in the amount of \$27,248 for engineering services to expand the sewer treatment plant.
