- Lucille Street Widen to 4-Lanes \$2,000,000
- E. Susitna Ave Extension \$1,500,000
- Gravel Road Paving \$1,000,000
- Wasilla Alternative Transportation Corridor \$500,000

WATER AND SEWER IMPROVEMENTS

- Sewer Treatment Plant Expansion \$3,000,000
- New Municipal Water Sources \$750,000
- Mission Hills Water Main Extension \$500,000
- Future Sewer Treatment Plant Study \$250,000
- Iditarod Reservoir Insulation \$150,000


PARKS AND RECREATION

- Sports Complex Portable Floor \$250,000
- Iditapark Amphitheater Stage Improvements \$100,000

- Sports Complex Kitchen \$650,000
- Public Service Message Board \$200,000





