History: On March 20, 2006, the Wasilla City Council defeated Resolution Serial No. 06-18, Transferring Funds Within An Accounting Fund In The Amount Of \$12,760 In Order To Fund A Deputy Administrator Position For The Reorganization Of The Planning Division And The Economic Development Department.

However, AM No. 06-12: Reorganizing The Planning Division Of Public Works And The Economic Development Department Into The Community And Economic Development Department Under The Supervision Of A Deputy Administrator, was postponed to the April 10, 2006 Regular City Council Meeting Agenda (see Unfinished Business). If the Council adopts AM No. 06-12 then Resolution Serial No. 06-25 should be adopted in order to fund the reorganization.

Resolution Serial No. 06-25 Summary Statement: The proposed resolution will reallocate FY 06 funding in order to fund the positions proposed in the reorganization of the planning and economic development functions into the Community and Economic Development Department under the supervision of a deputy administrator (see AM No. 06-12 for justification of the reorganization of the Planning Division and Economic Development Department into the Community and Economic Development Department). Funding projections of \$12,760 are based on making the change over on April 1st. The good news is that there are sufficient salary monies in the FY 06 Economic Development Department budget to fund the reorganization for this year.

Resolution Serial No. 06-25 will transfer monies into the Planning Division of Public Works from the Economic Development Department to cover the cost of 50% of the Deputy Administrator position (50% will be funded in the Economic Development Department).

We would actually combine the department budgets in FY 07 into one department named the Community and Economic Department.
