WHEREAS, Alaska Department of Transportation shows an average daily traffic count of 13,330 entering and leaving Wasilla along Knik-Goose Bay Road in 2004, and

WHEREAS, accident rates on Knik-Goose Bay Road are among the highest in the State, and

WHEREAS, traffic volumes are expected to significantly increase over the next 5 years with development occurring south of Wasilla.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Wasilla City Council supports the Borough's planning effort for Knik-Goose Bay road to be widened to 4-lanes between the City of Wasilla and Settler's Bay Subdivision.
