SUMMARY STATEMENT: The Phase 2 Improvements included the installation the water main along the Palmer-Wasilla Highway Extension from Knik-Goose Bay Road to Parks Highway near the Wasilla Police Station in 2005. The Phase 2 work has been closed out and a balance of \$127,782 of grant funding is available for the Phase 3 work that consists of the E. Susitna Well House near Home Depot. Note the \$127,782 amount reflects the revenue account transfer, whereas, only \$33,903 of that amount needs to be transferred to the corresponding expenditure account.

This resolution moves the balance of the original \$1,455,000 Environmental Protection Agency Grant for water and sewer improvements to the last project eligible for the grant, construction of the E. Susitna Well House.

RECOMMENDED ACTION: To adopt Resolution Serial No. 07-05 that transfers funds within an accounting fund in the amount of \$127,782 for Palmer-Wasilla Highway Water Improvements Phase 3.
