**A RESOLUTION OF THE WASILLA CITY COUNCIL SUPPORTING THE USE OF VACATED SPACE AT IDITAROD ELEMENTARY SCHOOL PREVIOUSLY USED FOR THE CENTRAL KITCHEN FACILITY TO BE USED FOR ELEMENTARY SCHOOL AGE STUDENTS, CLASS ROOMS, AND ACTIVITIES HELD AT IDITAROD ELEMENTARY SCHOOL.**

WHEREAS, the Matanuska-Susitna Borough School District has previously used space in the Iditarod Elementary School for the Central Kitchen Facility; and

WHEREAS, the Central Kitchen Facility has now vacated the space they used at Iditarod Elementary School; and

WHEREAS, the Iditarod Elementary School continues to experience a marked increase in students and it is projected an even greater increase in students for the upcoming 2007-2008 school year; and

WHEREAS, Iditarod Elementary School currently has several portable class rooms they use for students and activities.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Wasilla City Council, that we strongly encourage the Matanuska-Susitna Borough School Board to use the vacated space previously used by the Central Kitchen Facility at Iditarod Elementary School, for elementary school age students, class rooms, and activities held at Iditarod Elementary School; and

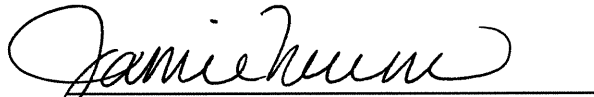
BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Wasilla City Council encourages the Matanuska-Susitna Borough School Board to budget funds to renovate the area previously used by the Central Kitchen Facility at Iditarod Elementary School so it may

be used for activities, classrooms and for elementary school age students attending Iditarod Elementary School; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that we believe the Iditarod Elementary School Campus, in its entirety, be utilized for elementary school age activities only.
