Hi Laurie and Sharita,

This email is regarding the Cultural Resource nomination for the Gil Turner's building at 6101 W Sunset Boulevard. If you could please send the below message to the Historic Preservation Commissioners in advance of the Monday, July 25th meeting, that would be much appreciated. I will be present at the meeting to discuss, should the commissioners have any questions.

I presented the Cultural Resource nomination for the Gil Turner's building to the HPC in April. The item was continued to a date certain of July 25th to give time to respond to questions and comments raised by the commission. Our team is very appreciative of the opportunity to come back and present more information. Since April, we have provided the city with an addendum to the nomination, which addresses issues raised on the building's significance, eligibility, and alterations in detail. We are making revisions to that document based on staff feedback. We very much look forward to sharing the addendum with you and making a presentation. While we attempted to complete this effort in time for the July 25th meeting, we needed more than just a few weeks to obtain access to the necessary research materials, such as early historic photos in the UCLA air photo archive, and drawings from the architect who did the rehabilitation work in 1999-2000. We are still waiting for scans of the drawings. We expect to have a revised draft to staff in the next couple of weeks. We would like to present the addendum to the HPC at an upcoming meeting and request the item be continued to a date uncertain, likely in September or October, to allow time for review and presentation of this material.
