STATEMENT ON THE SUBJECT

Established in 1980, the Certified Local Government (CLG) program encourages the preservation of historic and cultural resources by promoting a partnership between municipal governments, the State of California Office of Historic Preservation (OHP), and the National Park Service (NPS). Participating in the CLG program provides local staff and commissions with resources and technical training related to the preservation of said resources. The City of West Hollywood is a participant in the CLG program.

Each year, participating municipalities must file a report to the State of California OHP summarizing its historic preservation policies, programs, accomplishments, and goals. Cities must file annual reports in order to retain CLG certification. This year's annual report covers the period from October 1, 2021 to September 30, 2022.

Staff has prepared a draft annual report for the 2021-2022 reporting period as required for maintenance of the Local Government Certification. The annual report and all pertinent attachments are appended to this staff report as Exhibit A. The Commission is encouraged to review the report for adequacy, make any necessary revisions, and receive and file the report.
